RECEPTION VENUES

OUTDOOR RECEPTIONS

INDOOR RECEPTIONS

Water's Edge Ballroom is a unique indoor circular venue with floor-to-ceiling windows overlooking the Lagoon Lanai and waterfall.

Grand Ballroom is the largest indoor reception venue and has the unique feature of three stepped levels for seating. This layout offers all participants an unobstructed view of the main stage. The ballroom can be divided into seven sections - the Monarchy section being the central and largest portion of the facility, flanked by the six King's and Queen's rooms, which can either be included in the wide-open Grand Ballroom, or partitioned off from it, as needed.

Kohala Ballroom is the second-largest indoor facility available. Its familiar rectangular space is divisible into four sections of approximately 2,500 square feet each.

Kona Ballroom is also one of the largest reception locations. This ballroom can be divided into five sections, two large rooms or three smaller rooms accommodating 100 or more attendees.

Kamuela Provision Company is located oceanfront near the Lagoon Tower. This captivating restaurant is the perfect setting for small and intimate receptions with spectacular sunset views. KPC offers indoor and outdoor seating and the private Nai'a Room can accommodate up to 20 guest.

DUAL CEREMONY & RECEPTION VENUES

For couples looking to host their ceremony and reception in the same location, Hilton Waikoloa Village offers a few venues that are versatile enough to accommodate both aspects of the event.

Dolphin Quest is a truly unique and memorable wedding location as it offers couples the opportunity to tie-the-knot with jumping dolphins and a private ocean fed lagoon in the background.
