The coast off Waikoloa Beach Resort is home to some of the world's most stunning sunset displays, which are honored each night by a fire runner who indicates the start of sunset by blowing a conch shell and lighting the tiki torch trail that lines the property's coastline.

Couples can bask in the sunset while enjoying a private dinner experience at Buddha Point, while laying in a hammock hung from two native palm trees, lounging in a private poolside cabana bed for two, or at one of the many oceanfront restaurants. Couples are encouraged to enjoy the sunset while sipping on traditional Hawaiian beverages or the resort's signature 180-second cocktail, named for the amount of time it takes the sun to set after touching the horizon.

CULTURAL IMMERSION HONEYMOON

Waikoloa Beach Resort is a gateway to cultural immersion, engaging honeymooners in the area's rich history through interactive cultural entertainment and luaus, historic Petroglyph tours, authentic local treatments at the Kohala Spa, Dolphin Quest educational center, dining outlets with island-oriented meals inspired by local ingredients and a Museum Walkway with 1,800 pieces of art from around the world, all of which inspired the culture of Hawaii.

Daily and weekly hotel cultural activities range from coconut husking, ulu maika (Hawaiian disc rolling) demonstrations and lei making to Hawaiian stories on the weekly resort activity calendar and Hawaiian checkers games placed throughout the resort. In March, the **Ukulele Festival** is Hawaii's greatest gathering of ukulele

professionals and fans. On May 1, Waikoloa Beach Resort celebrates **Lei Day** and brings Hawaiian natives and visitors together to celebrate the craft of lei making.

Believed to be the first Hawaiian Island discovered and settled by Polynesians, perhaps as early as the fifth century, Hawaii's Big Island has been the scene of many of the state's historic events and sites.

- Hawaii's Big Island is the youngest and largest of the Hawaiian Islands with 4,028 square miles and it's still growing as long as lava continues to pour out of Kilauea, the world's most active volcano, which has been continually erupting since 1983.
- Mauna Loa - the world's largest active volcano.
- The Big Island is home to 1,660 species of flowering plants and 45 species of birds found nowhere else on Earth.
- Hawaii's Big Island is a worldwide leader in harvesting macadamia nuts and orchids and is the only place in the United States where vanilla and cacao beans (the raw material used to make chocolate) are grown. Kona is also the only place in the United States where gourmet coffee is grown.
